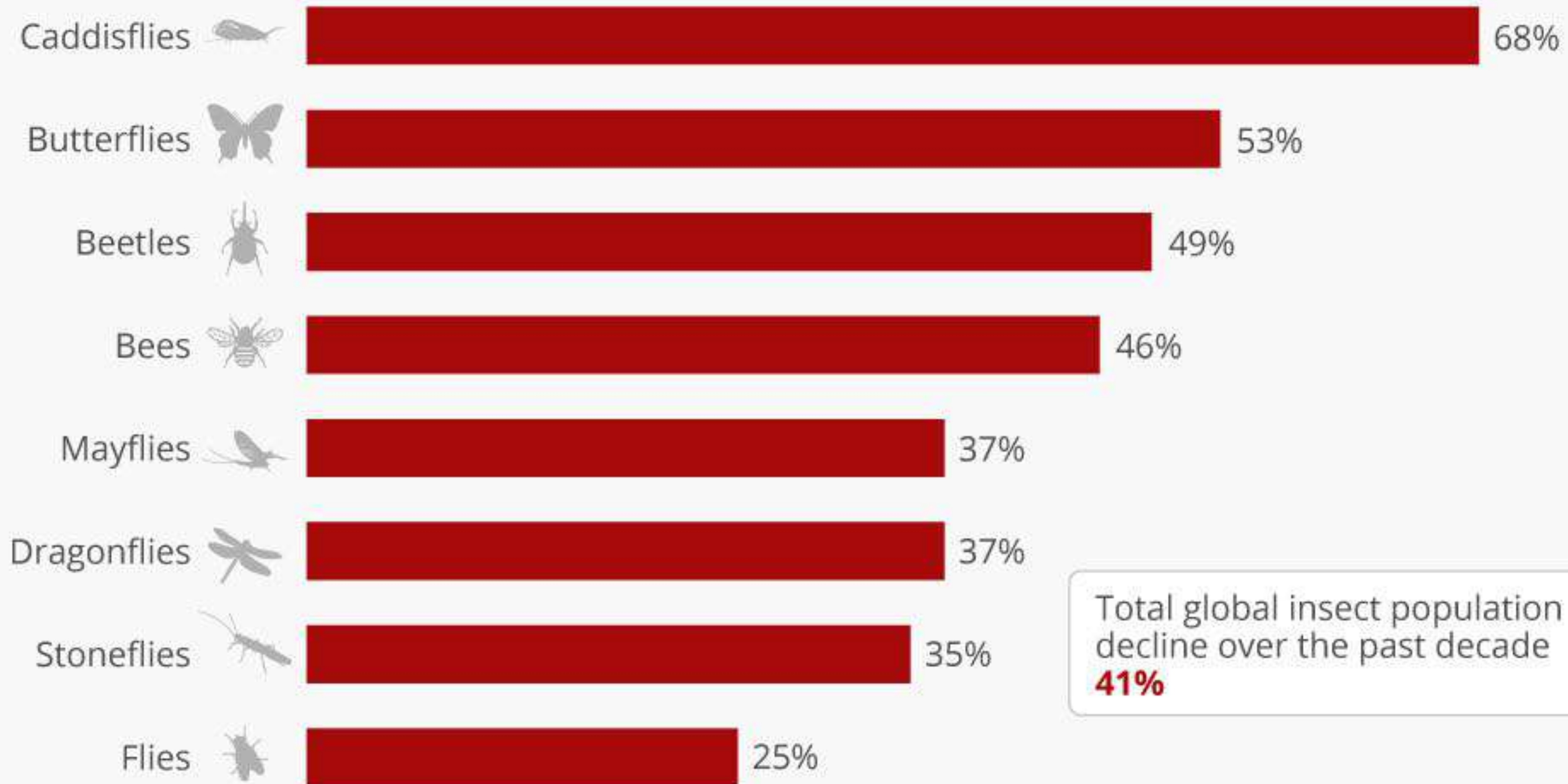

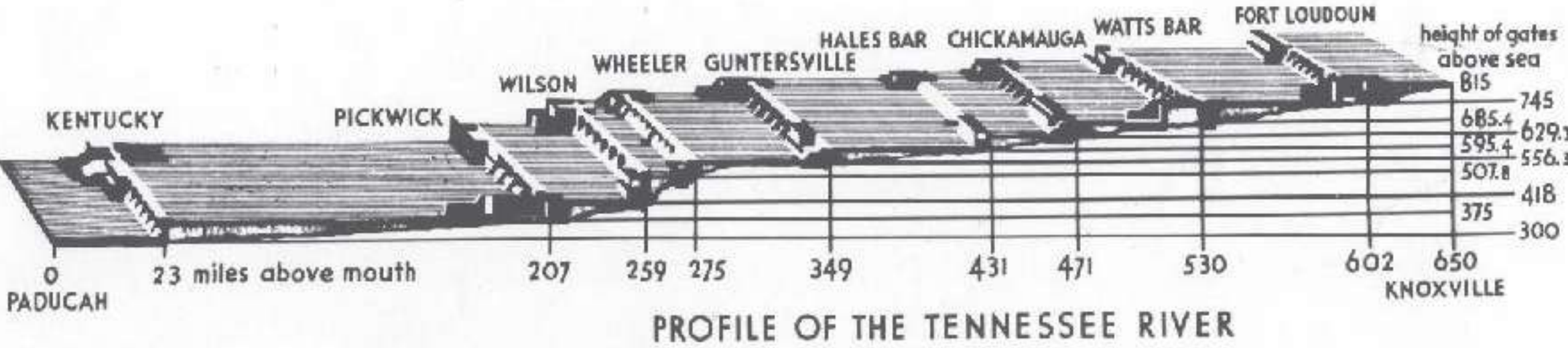

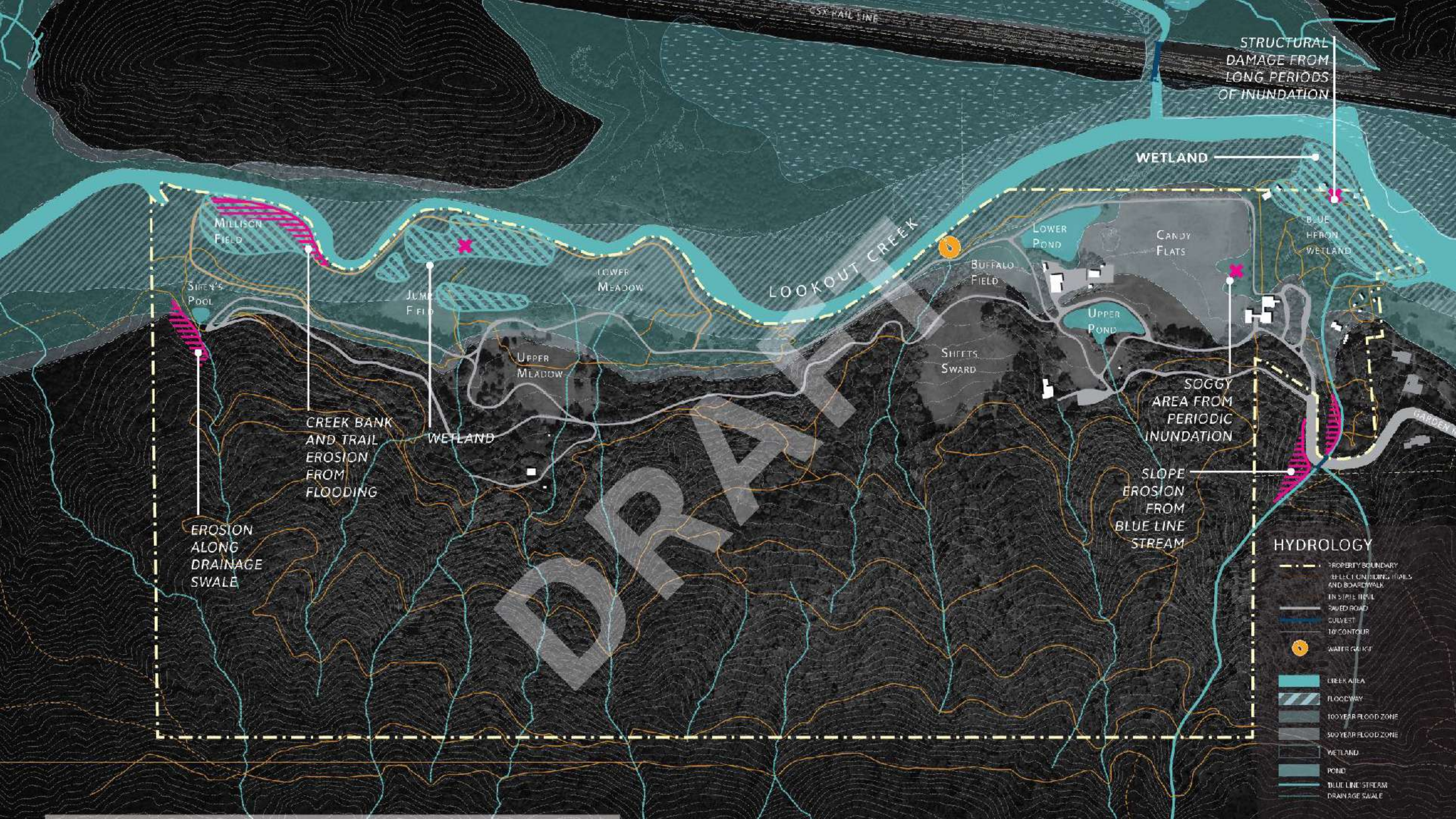

**+ EASTERN KINGBIRD**  
Tyrannus tyrannus



Kingbirds breed across the US and migrate in small flocks. They can be found perched on fence posts in fields, meadows, and along forest edges.

**+ RUBY-THROATED HUMMINGBIRD**  
Archilochus colubris



A favorite for at-home birdwatchers, these little birds breeds throughout the eastern United States before wintering in Central America

**+ CERULEAN WARBLER**  
Dendroica cerula

These colorful birds come from as far as South America to breed in the mature hardwood forests of Tennessee



**+ SANDHILL CRANE**  
Grus canadensis  
Antigone canadensis



The Hiwassee Wildlife Refuge serves as a migratory rest stop for these cranes as they move from their breeding grounds in the northern United States and Canada to their wintering grounds in Florida and Mexico

**+ NORTHERN PARULA**  
Setophaga americana



These small warblers breed throughout the eastern United States before wintering in the Carribean. They can be spotted in the canopies of wet, bottomland forests.

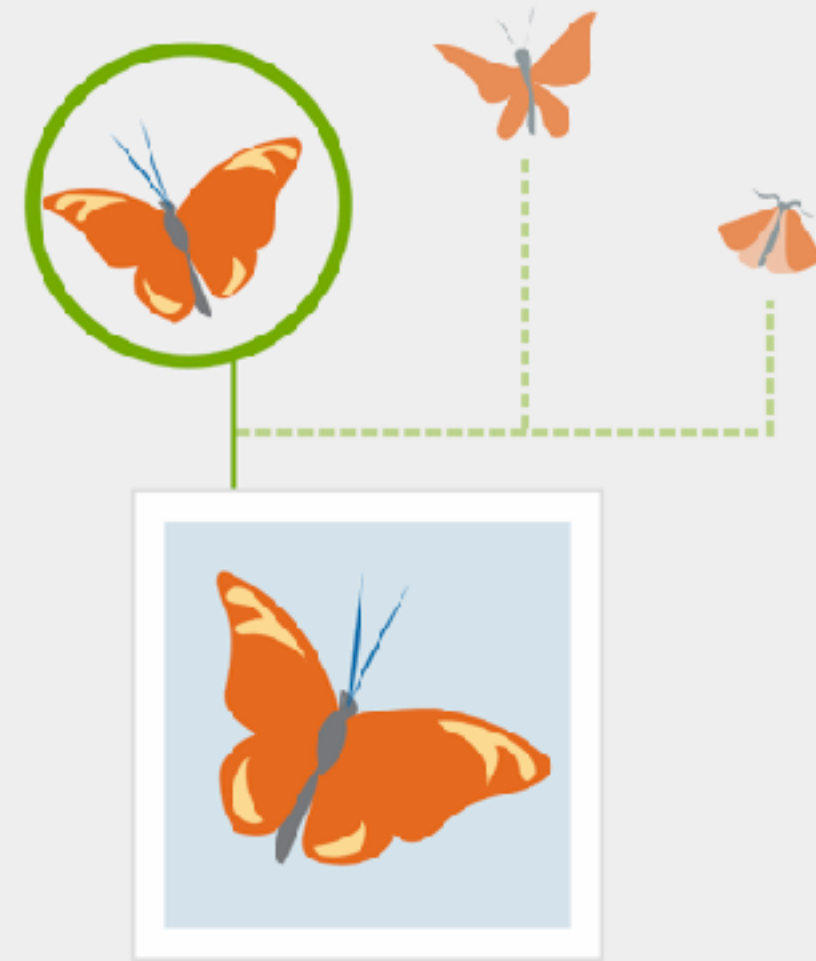

Your observation may be vetted as Research Grade and shared with scientists working to better understand and protect nature.

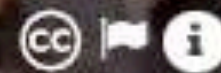

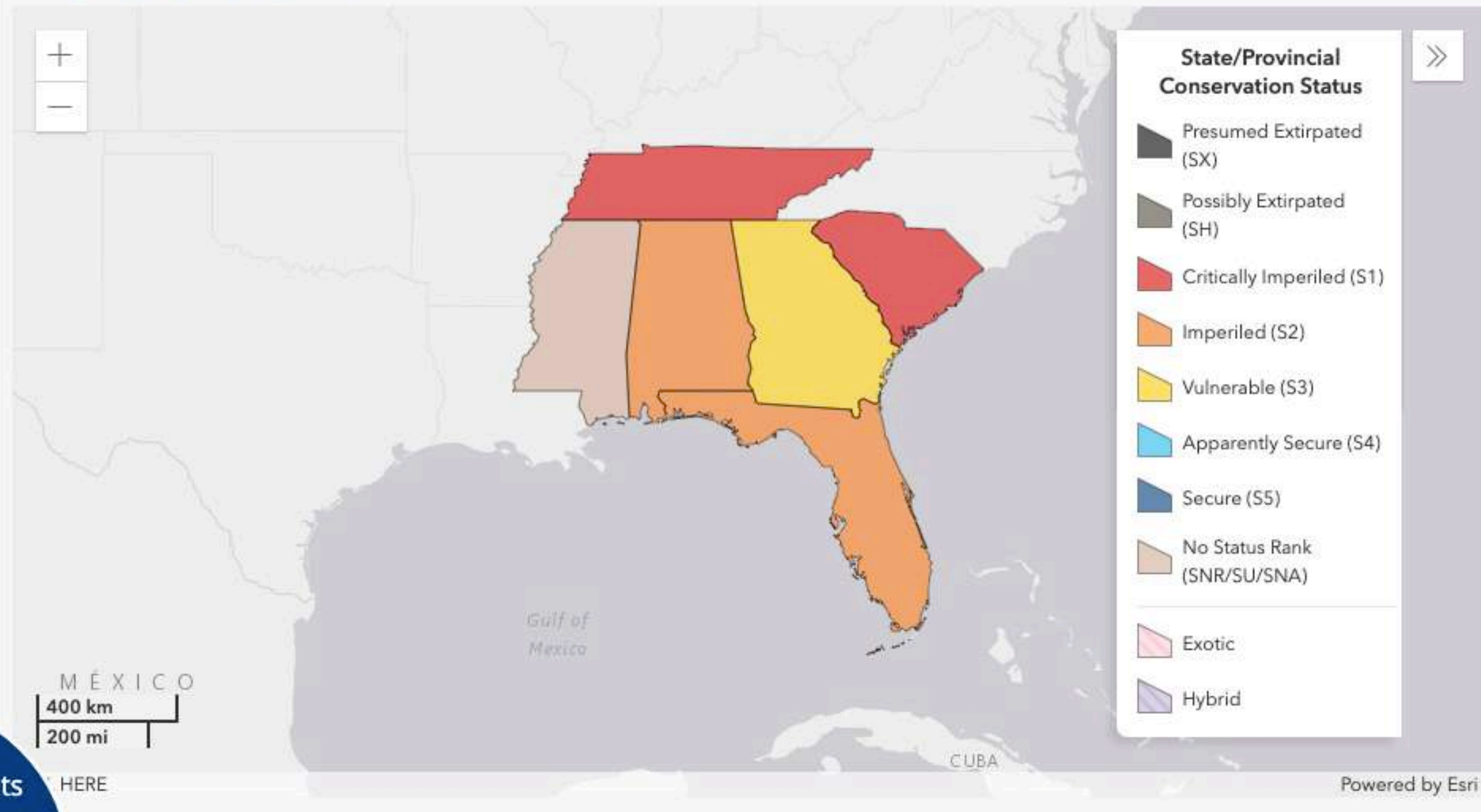

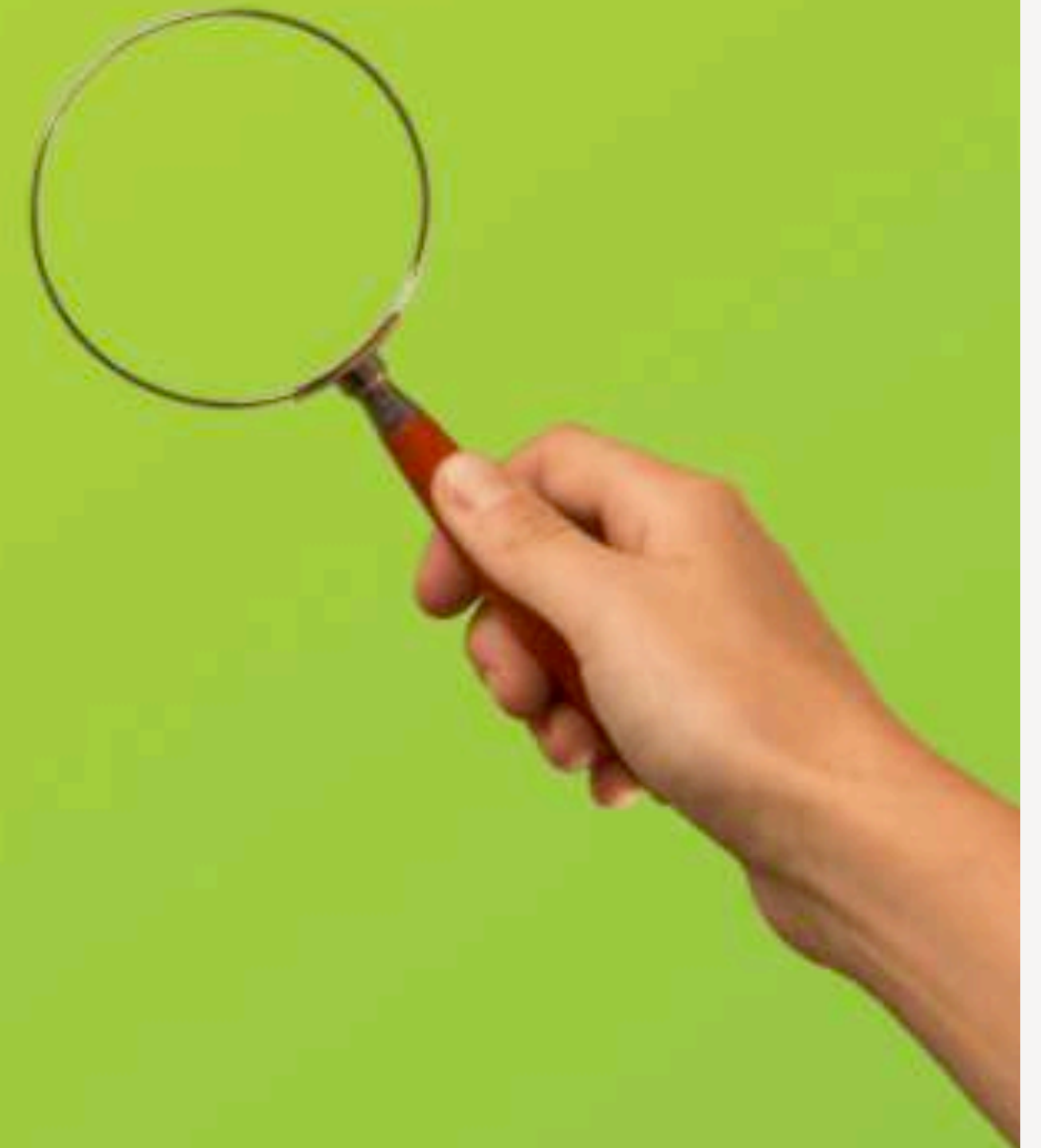
